Co-Design Learning for the School of the Future - Co.De. Project

The Co.De. project in a nutshell:

The Co.De. project aims to tackle early school leaving by providing innovative e-tools to implement codesign learning paths in classrooms.

The first thread of activities will be aimed at delivering a competence model on co-design and the microlearning opportunities on co-design learning, both addressed to EU teachers from secondary schools.

The second thread of activities will be aimed at delivering a Co.De. toolkit 4 Classrooms, a Moodle-based platform, designed and developed to support secondary schools (teachers and students) in trying to use and adopt concretely the co-design learning in the classroom through a multidisciplinary approach.

Co.De.'s target groups are:

- > Teachers from EU secondary schools
- > 12-18 years old students
- EU secondary schools
- The labor market and civil society

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A focus on Work Package 2 - Co.De. 4 Teachers:

The Co.De. Consortium started working on the 'Co.De. 4 Teachers', aimed at formalizing a **Competence Model**, with skills, abilities and knowledge required in a teacher to be able to use the co-design approach in classroom, and developing an **e-questionnaire** to self-assess the teachers' readiness in co-design learning and approach and **learning snacks** for supporting them in filling gaps on co-design.

To ensure strong involvement and real adherence to the needs of the target group, the partners also organized **thematic focus groups** with teachers and instructors, whose feedback has been collected in a **comparative report** with ad-hoc suggestions for setting up and improving the Co.De. Competence Model.

While the Competence Model and the e-questionnaire are ready and will be online soon, in October the Consortium started designin **7 training learning snacks** addressed to fill the teachers' gaps in co-design learning. News soon!
